- Show Hotel:** DoubleTree Guest Suites Dayton/Miamisburg, 300 Prestige Place, Miamisburg, Ohio 45342 937-436-2287

- Banquet:** Will be held at the DoubleTree. Reception starts 6:30pm and Dinner begins at 7:30pm followed by awards ceremony.
- Airports:** Dayton International Airport (DAY), Cincinnati (CVG), Columbus (CMH)
- Show Hours:** FRIDAY: Check-in will be from 1:30pm-3:00pm, Show Hours are 3pm – 10pm, open to the public
SATURDAY: Check-in will be from 7:30am – 8:30 am, Show Hours are 9am – 4pm, open to the public
SUNDAY: Check-in will be from 8:30 am – 9 am, Show Hours are 9am – 4pm, open to the public
*Permission from show management must be obtained to leave earlier than posted show hours, or risk losing all points from the show.
- Supplies:** Cat litter will be provided in the show hall only. Please bring your own litter pans. No cat food or water will be provided.
- Cages:** Single cages (1/2 cage) measuring 22"L x 22"W x 22"H; Double cages (whole cage) are 44"L x 22"W x 22"H. The top, sides, and back of cages MUST be covered. Grooming space is 44"L x 22"W x 22"H. No more than one adult cat or two kittens are allowed per single cage. No 1/2 cages or grooms without purchase of extra 1/2 cage.
- Benching:** All exhibitors will have assigned benching. Benching requests MUST be clearly indicated on the summary sheets, and we will try to accommodate all requests. No one may change their benching without permission of show management. Under no circumstances are kittens or cats allowed to be kept in kennels/carriers under the benching spaces.
- For Sale:** Cats and kittens for sale will be permitted. Kittens must be three calendar months of age. Proof of age must be provided upon request. Sales cages are available ONLY for exhibitors with paid competitive entries.
- Health Rules:** This is a non-vetted show. It is recommended that all entries be up to date on all immunizations. Any cats showing evidence of fungus, ear mites, fleas, or a contagious disease will be removed from the show hall as well as any other cats owned, housed, or agented by the same exhibitor. TICA show rules require all claws, front and back, be clipped prior to judging. Household Pet Adults (8 months or older) must be spayed/neutered.
- Eligibility for entry:** Must have a TICA registration number: Preliminary/Advanced New Breeds & New Traits
Must have a TICA registration number, or provide proof of eligibility for TICA registration: Kitten, Championship and Alter
May enter without a TICA registration: Household Pet Kittens, Household Pet Adults
Registration is necessary for your entry to be scored for titles, regional and international awards.
Championship cats, kittens, alters and household pet adults will only be scored once without registration. To obtain information about registration with TICA call 956-428-8046, e-mail registration@ticaeo.com, or write to the TICA Executive Office at P.O. Box 2684, Harlingen, TX 78551.
- Awards:** Each entry will receive a rosette at the beginning of the show. Awards plaques will be given in all rings for finals in accordance with TICA Show Rules.
- Show Rules:** TICA show rules and related rules will be strictly enforced. By entering, exhibitors agree to abide by these rules. Show rules may be obtained from the TICA Executive Office. Contact information listed in previous paragraph or you may print a copy from the TICA website:

- Payment:** E-mailed entries will be accepted; however payment must be mailed within 24 hours. We also accept credit cards and e-checks via PayPal. PayPal is free, to sign up just go to PayPal.com. Payments should be made to the following address: toledoshow@aol.com Checks returned by the bank for any reason must be immediately repaid, including a club-issued bounced check fee of \$40 per check.
- Clerks & Stewards:** Clerks and stewards are always needed and greatly appreciated. Please indicate on your summary sheet if you are able to clerk or steward. Licensed clerks will be given priority and judge requests will be honored to the best of our ability. Do NOT deduct clerking/stewarding fees from your entry fees. Payment will be given at the end of the weekend. Clerks will be compensated \$30 per session, plus lunch and a marked catalog. Stewards will be compensated \$15 per session, plus lunch.
- Children/Smoking:** For the comfort of our exhibitors and spectators: The show hall area will be designated as non-smoking. Children are always welcome at our shows, but for the enjoyment of all, we request that youngsters be supervised at all times. Show management reserves the right to ask parents to control or remove disruptive children as well as any other disruptive exhibitors, spectators, cats, etc.
